- What kind of development do you do? Can you talk a bit about the product you work on?
- How often do you visit reddit? How much time do you spend?
- Did you realize that you were among the top X% of posters / commenters on r/programming?
- What other sub-reddits are you active in?
- What do you think about reddit?
- What motivates you to read/visit reddit?

Hacker News

- Are you active on HackerNews as well?
- If yes, why are you active on both? What does one give you that the other doesn't? What's the difference between both?
- What other websites do you use for these purposes?
- How do these compare to Twitter?

Contribution

- For each of the participants' most recent X posts and comments: What triggered this particular contribution (e.g., last post or comment)?
- For posts, where did you find the content to post?
- Why do you post?
- Why do you comment on r/programming?
- Are these the same reasons you post / comment on HackerNews?
- Do you remember the last time you upvoted / downvoted a contribution? Why?
- How important is Reddit karma to you? Why?
- Have you been in touch or shared experiences with any other reddit user?

Reading/Learning

- Why do you read r/programming and HackerNews?
- How would you characterize their content? Is there a difference between r/programming and HackerNews in terms of content?
- When do you read these sources?
- Do you use any tools to access these sources, or do you look at the "raw" websites?
- What's the last important thing you've learned on r/programming or HackerNews?
- How has this information impacted your programming?
- Do you share what you learn on these websites with others in your network (i.e., project, company, etc.)?
- Do you trust what you read?
- Do you perceive impolite people in reddit? Have you been?

Advice/Pitfalls/Barriers/Challenges

- What advice do you have for other developers when posting/reading news?
- What pitfalls should others watch for?
- What do you think is the impact of these websites on the broader software development community (positive / negative)?
- How could r/programming and HackerNews be improved?
